



Due to the generosity of Foundation donors, major strategic goals were accomplished this fiscal year as outlined below:

- More than \$487,100 was awarded to the following program recipients
- 88 scholarships totaling \$263,750 to support nurse anesthesia
- 2 research grants totaling \$197,791 - 1 educational grant totaling \$5,000
- 2 student research grants totaling \$6,800
- 1 CRNA Scholar totaling \$9,856
- 82 poster presentations at AANA Annual Congress totaling \$4,000
- 67 Student Educational Emergency Scholarships (SEES) totaling \$165,250
- Honored the following CRNAs -Virginia Gaffey, Brooklyn Castilla, and Clare Golden – for their efforts in the areas of philanthropy, advocacy and volunteerism.
- Nationwide representation by 47 State Advocates and 73 Student Advocates in FY23.

- 210 research grants to CRNAs totaling \$1,363,416
- 70 student research grants totaling \$93,578
- 2,632 poster presentations at AANA Annual Congress and ADCE totaling \$180,750
- 1,506 scholarships totaling \$ 2,842,500 to support nurse anesthesia
- 191 fellowships/CRNA Scholars totaling more than \$1,337,109 to assist CRNAs and SRNAs pursuing their PhD and DNP degrees
- · Since 2017, over \$1.9 million has been allocated to 12 Health Policy Research Studies for total funding of more than \$7.7 million
